- **GEORGE HARVAN**, photos of Pennsylvania mines and miners, 1940s-1970s, including breakers, mine disasters, historical figures. A native of the area, Harvan became nationally recognized, taking 100s of photos which reflect the harsh reality of miners' lives.
- **YOUNG ARTISTS OF PENNSYLVANIA PRIZE SELECTIONS**: Ryan Hnat, Andrew Hart and John Tronsor. Aged 28 and under, these artists are part of the "Innovation Generation," having been influenced by growing up in the current technological era.
- **PAINTINGS OF EMILIO CRUZ and JOHN HULTBERG**, who both painted in an expressionist style using the figure as a central theme.
